## Important Convention Information

### Special By-laws Meeting

There will be a special meeting for the purpose of review, explanation, discussion and final vote of the proposed ICES Bylaws revision on Thursday evening, August 4 at 8:00 pm in room 213 A of the Convention Center. You are strongly encouraged to attend this important meeting. Please review the proposed By-laws found in the June issue of the ICES Newsletter. A copy of the proposed By-laws may also be found at <http://www.ices.org/legal/legal.html>. You can also find a red-lined version of the document and a comparison document. If you wish to vote on the bylaws you either must attend the meeting and receive a ballot, *or if not attending* — give someone you trust a proxy to vote for you, *or* request and send in an absentee ballot WHICH IS VALID ONLY FOR THIS MEETING!

If you wish to vote during the regular General Membership Meeting on Friday morning, you must be present and accounted for with a voting sheet at the meeting, *or if not attending* — send in a separate proxy for only this meeting with someone you trust, *or* request and send in a separate absentee ballot for this meeting. Voting at the General Membership Meeting will involve the usual items of electing our 2011/2012 Board members and officers, and any motions brought forth from the general membership. *It will not address the bylaws!*

**In other words, if you are not going to the convention you will need TWO SEPARATE proxies/absentee ballots to vote in both of these meetings.**

**You must be an ICES member in good standing to vote. Any member can carry up to 5 proxy ballots for other members. Absentee ballots must be returned postmarked by JUNE 23, 2011.**
